## Moving Forward in Spite of The Current Strife

In our last newsletter we explained that because of the many serious problems of gang violence and kidnappings taking place in the country of Haiti, we chose to travel to The Dominican Republic to explore other avenues of ministry, while continuing to work remotely as coordinators with our Haitian Ministry Partners. Since then, the situation has grown even worse, forcing us to cancel our October Trip.

While waiting upon The Lord, our conversations with **Pastor Leon Joseph** revealed how difficult it had become for him to continue with their church's Christian School. Many challenges were similar to church schools here in the U.S. But when we learned how basic some of their needs actually were - Teachers without books to teach from and monthly salaries less than a "day's wage" here, no food for students who come without having anything at all to eat at home (all food in the country has been diverted to the earthquake zone), we felt very burdened! Even the Haitians have the Creole saying: "The hungry stomach has no ears."

A plan began to develop that made perfect sense! If any difference is to be made in that country, it certainly lies with God! The spreading of The Gospel of Christ to the lost, further discipleship of the Body of Christ, and the Christian Education of the young - the future leaders of Haiti, are all ministries that we can help with. However, until now, we have not partnered in a major way regarding Christian Education. With God's Help we are planning to partner with this school ministry.
